THE EMBASSY OF THE PHILIPPINES WISHES TO INFORM THE FILIPINO COMMUNITY IN THE STATE OF KUWAIT, SPECIALLY THOSE WHO APPLIED FOR REGISTRATION AS OVERSEAS ABSENTEE VOTER ON FEBRUARY TO AUGUST 2009 THAT THE VOTER'S IDENTIFICATION CARDS ARE NOT YET AVAILABLE, HENCE, THERE IS NO NEED YET FOR THEM TO COME TO THE EMBASSY TO CLAIM THE ID.

THE VOTER'S IDENTIFICATION CARD WILL BE AVAILABLE IN DUE TIME.

MEANWHILE, THE OVERSEAS ABSENTEE VOTING FOR PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SENATORS AND PARTY LIST WILL START 10 APRIL AND WILL CONTINUE UNINTERRUPTED UNTIL 10 MAY 2010. THE EMBASSY REITERATES ITS ADVISORY TO REGISTERED VOTERS TO SCHEDULE THEIR DAYS OFF IN ADVANCE TO AVOID COMPLICATIONS IN THEIR SCHEDULES. QUALIFIED VOTERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO GET OUT AND CAST THEIR VOTES.
